## Sensible Gun Safety Ministry

Friday, June 7 is National Gun Violence Awareness Day, adopted in 2015 with the purpose of combating the ongoing tragic gun violence epidemic. On average, 96 people are shot and killed every day in America. While we have a right to bear arms, we have a responsibility to use guns safely and sensibly. All across America people will be marching and demonstrating to promote safety and awareness. The movement began in 2013 to commemorate the life of 15 year old Hadiya Pendleton, who was fatally shot in Chicago, an accidental casualty of gang violence. Friends and family chose to honor her by wearing the color orange, the color hunters wear to keep from being shot accidentally.

The entire weekend will be dedicated to wearing orange in memory of those that lost their lives through gun violence. On Saturday, June 8, there will be a Walk Across the Brooklyn Bridge in NY in support of family and friends of survivors of gun violence. The Solidarity Walk With Survivors will begin in Brooklyn at Cadman Plaza at noon. See
